Cash distributions were paid in 2013 as described below. A portion of each of the cash distributions was a non-dividend distribution.

\$0.160000 per share was paid on 4/15/13 to common shareholders of record as of 3/29/13

\$.0160000 per share was paid on 7/15/13 to common shareholders of record as of 6/28/13

\$.0160000 per share was paid on 10/15/13 to common shareholders of record as of 9/27/13

15 Describe the quantitative effect of the organizational action on the basis of the security in the hands of a U.S. taxpayer as an adjustment per share or as a percentage of old basis ▶

Cyrusone Inc. has determined that of such distributions described above, approximately 46.94350% (or \$0.0751096 per share) will be treated as a taxable dividend and 53.05650% (or \$0.0848904 per share) will be treated as a return of capital under Section 301(c)(2). Generally, the portion of each distribution on the common stock that is treated as return of capital should reduce the tax basis in the shares of common stock up to a holder's adjusted basis in the common stock, with any excess treated as capital gains pursuant to Section 301(c)(3).

16 Describe the calculation of the change in basis and the data that supports the calculation, such as the market values of securities and the valuation dates ▶

The portion of each distribution that represents a taxable dividend was paid out of current earnings and profits and the nontaxable distributions were calculated as the amount of cash distribution in excess of earnings and profits.
